Sub: Measures for controlling oil pollution & protection of marine environment

For the purpose of protection of Yemen's marine environment by the virtue of its competence,

MAA would like to inform you that it is in its process of applying measures to monitor ships to ensure their compliance with the law of marine environment protection No. 16 for the Year 2004, seize violators, and apply measures against them, starting from July 15, 2007.

The aforementioned measures include the following:

- Inspection to the ships (randomly sampled), which call at the Yemeni ports and terminals, by MAA inspectors to check Oil log Books and Oil RESIDUE RECIEPT issued by the last port of call to compare it with the contents of SLOP TANK to ensure that the ship did not discharge waste oil into Yemen's territorial water, Economic Zone, Continental Shelf, and Exclusive Zone.

Please be informed that MAA would apply strict measures, in accordance with the law against any violators.

Based upon the abovementioned, you are kindly requested to report this notification to ship owners, operators, and chatters and to whom it may concern
